

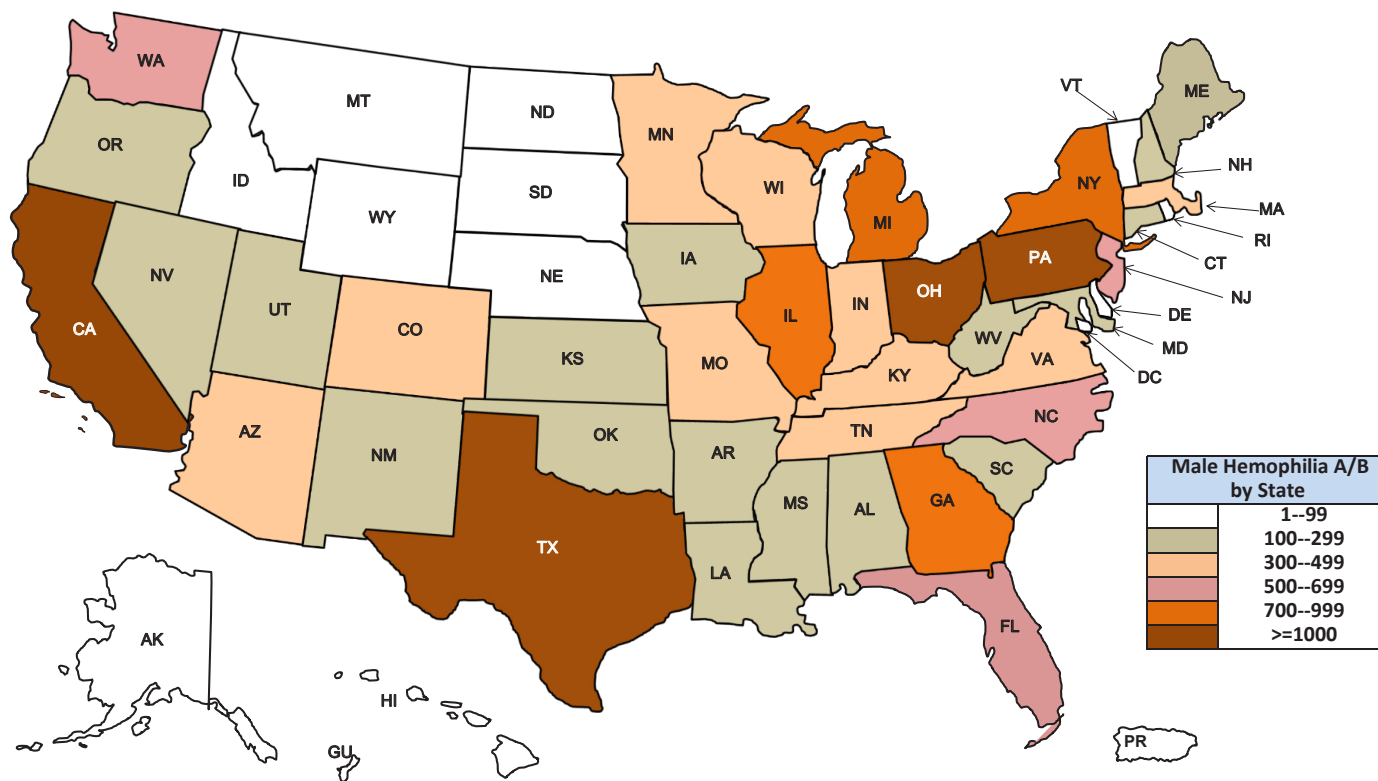
GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

HEMOPHILIA A/B



This data was provided to us by the CDC, and is up-to-date as of May 2017. However, it is estimated that nearly 1/3 of the patients with hemophilia do not go to Hemophilia Treatment Centers (HTCs). HFA's CHOICE program has collected information on the state of this population.

Geographic distribution of males with hemophilia A or B attending federally funded integrated-care Hemophilia Treatment Centers by state of residence, 1/2012-12/2016



Note: This map presents the number of individuals who attended the hemophilia treatment centers (HTCs) during the period 1/1/2012-12/31/2016 and who were entered into the HTC Population Profile (<https://www.cdc.gov/ncbddd/hemophilia/communitycounts/about.html>) as of 12/31/2016. Individuals are counted only once, regardless of the number of times they attended an HTC during this period.
