TEAM LEADERS

ROLE

Make introductions, field technical questions, make sure meeting runs smoothly.

CONSTITUENT

ROLE

Whoever lives in the state of the office we are in

Tell your story!

OTHER

ROLE

Everyone else in the room

Help the constituent discuss hemophilia and the issues.

HOW A TYPICAL MEEETING WILL GO

1 Team Leader will: 1) introduce themselves and give a brief overview of HFA; 2) give staff the informational folder; 3) mention that we are having a Hill Day and have brought in community members to discuss various issues. Team leader will indicate which constituent is from the state of the office we are in, and let the staffer know how many are affected by hemophilia in that state.

3 Team Leader will field technical questions about the issues if necessary.

4 That **constituent** will then tell their story about how hemophilia impacts them, being sure to highlight the cost of factor, the importance of treating prophylactically at home and having timely access to medicine.

2 Constituent will start discussin the issues that we are there to discuss.

5 The rest of the **community members** can feel free to help each other along here in discussing the issues.
